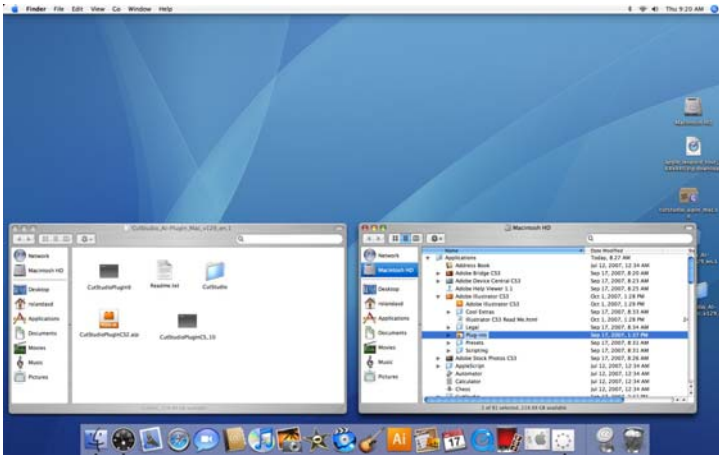

The following document covers how to cut from Adobe Illustrator CS3 on Intel-based Macintosh computers running OSX. Before beginning, please make sure you have downloaded the Plugin stuffit file from our website to your desktop:

1. Extract the stuffit file. You should have a folder on your desktop titled "CutStudio_AIPlugin_Mac_v129_en" Open this folder on your desktop. Next open "Macintosh HD" on your desktop. Leave both windows open as in the screenshot below:



2. From the v129 folder on the left, drag "CutStudioPluginCS2.aip" in the "plugins" folder of Adobe Illustrator CS3 as in the screenshot below:



3. After dragging the plugin into the "plugins" folder is successful, next drag the "CutStudio" folder into the main "Applications" directory of Macintosh HD as seen in the screenshot below:

6. Now open Adobe Illustrator CS3 and output your cut file.

** Note, when using Leopard and/or multiple hard drives: The "CutStudioPluginCS2.aip" must be installed in the plugins folder of Adobe Illustrator CS3, regardless of location. The "CutStudio" folder must be installed in the "Applications" directory of the primary hard drive.
