FAQ - MPX-60

Q: How do you correct the image so that it impacts in the correct area of a pendant?

A:

- 1. Ensure that the rubber pad is properly installed on the table (refer to page 57 of the Users Manual for procedure).
- 2. Ensure that the material is centered on the grid on the rubber pad (There are arrows on the rubber pad that indicate the center points).
- 3. Using one of the 4 brass plates that came with the machine, carry out the offset adjustment (refer to page 62 in the Users Manual for procedure).
- 4. Also the use of templates will ensure that the image fits in the area of the pendant being impacted. Templates can be obtained free of charge from www.eimimage.com or www.mpx60.com.
