Questions

Can Roland ColorChoice 4.0 and Roland ColorChoice 3.0 be installed in the same Windows OS computer?

Answers

Yes. However, the computer could cause a conflict when starting both Roland ColorChoice 4.0 and Roland ColorChoice 3.0. On a Windows Computer, Roland ColorChoice will start automatically when you turn on the computer. Make sure to remove Roland ColorChoice from the STARTUP menu and start each application separately.

Then, you will be able to have both versions of RCC installed on one computer.

 - 8 GB hard disk
 - Mac OS 8.5 or later
 - PCI slot for ECP Parallel card
 - USB PIA Cable
