

Will Your Roland ColorChoice and SignMate Software Products Run on Non-Intel Chips? (Cyrix, AMD, DEC, etc.)

The official policy is that the software requires an Intel Pentium processor to run. The software should run on other processors, but some are lower quality and can cause random problems that are hard to troubleshoot.

The main requirement of the products on the PC platform is that the user has Windows 95/98 or NT. All software testing is done on Intel processors. Other Processors are certified by Microsoft to run Windows properly, but may have conflicts between the processor and the motherboard. You can check the web site of the processor to see if Microsoft recommends your particular motherboard. We believe that our products can run on non-Intel Pentium systems, but there may be problems that arise due to the quality of the system. Usually non-Intel Pentium systems are less expensive and are built for the consumer market. They use less expensive components and are not really appropriate for our users. This applies to all manufacturers of PCs. Consumer PCs have different requirements than business PCs.
